
## How much should I give?

### **Youth & Young Adults**

Focusing on opportunities for young people across the diocese so they can grow closer to Christ.

### **Catholic Schools**

Providing quality education in diverse settings, while building community and proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ in all 31 Catholic schools across the diocese.

### Life, Marriage, and Family

Supporting the growth and development of married and family life by offering a range of activities retreats and conferences that foster love of Christ and one another

### **Lay Formation and RCIA**

Supporting men and women living out their Christian vocation through education, prayer, reflection, and discernment.

### **Faith Formation**

Seeking to form disciples by inviting those in the diocese to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ.

#### **Vocations**

Assisting men and women who are discerning God's plan for their life.

## **Evangelization & Mission Advancement**

### Courier

Keeping diocesan parishioners informed of local, national, and global news that affects their church. Diocesan directors are regular contributors each month.

### TV Mass, Social Media, and Website

Meeting people with the Word of God where they're at, be it on a computer, a Smartphone, or a television. TV Mass is broadcast weekly, and social media and the website provide information of interest.

### **Newman Centers-Winona and Mankato**

Helping university students encounter Christ through a variety of activities at the two public university campuses within the diocese.

## **Community Service**

### **Catholic Charities Social Action**

Providing service to people in need and advocating for justice in social circles. Staff and volunteers serve more than 6,400 people a year, including families in crisis, seniors, refugees, and the poor.

## **Parish Services & Outreach**

### **Parish Financial Services**

Full-time diocesan staff are available daily to support parishes with accounting, benefits, and human resources.

### Cemeteries

Providing resources, support, and training for those who work in Catholic cemeteries throughout the diocese.

### **Divine Worship**

Bringing our bishop and parishioners together to celebrate God's goodness through the Chrism Mass, Rite of Election, Ordinations, and other sacred rituals of the Church.

### **Hispanic Ministry**

There are currently 12 parishes in the diocese that offer Spanish Masses. Youth Hispanic Ministry at Queen of Angels—Austin, increased from 45 to 250 children in the last four years.

## **Clergy Services**

### **Care for Priests**

Underwrites the costs of programs related to the ongoing intellectual, spiritual, human, and pastoral formation of priests.

### **Hispanic Chaplaincy**

Providing support for Hispanic priests so they can provide programs specific to more than 21.000 Hispanic individuals across the diocese.
